Ami has over 20 years of experience in Israel's hi-tech ecosystem. As part of Meitar Law Offices (Israel's biggest and leading law firm) since 2006, Ami has worked on hundreds of transactions in the tech sector, including commercial transactions such as technology licensing, as well as corporate transactions such as mergers and acquisitions, private equity financings, venture capital, banking, and advisory work. Ami has substantial experience in structuring and negotiating complex cross-border transactions, particularly with multinational companies based in East Asia. Ami holds vast expertise in public law, regulatory, crisis management, and risk and compliance matters. Ami represents individuals, corporations, and organizations before the Israeli regulators and government bodies.

Ami served as Senior Adviser at the Israeli Prime Minister's Office (2000-2005), advising the highest levels of the Israeli government on issues ranging from legal to social and economic affairs.

Ami has been co-founder and Chairman of MAC Fund, the first Israel-Korea venture capital fund focused on investment in hi-tech startups in the fields of medical devices and life sciences. The fund has invested in 15 companies and successfully completed three major exits. In 2024, Ami joined as a partner at Trepont Fund, a new \$80M Korea-Israel-Silicon Valley Korea Deeptech Fund.

Ami is the Honorary Consul General for the Republic of Korea in Israel.

Ami is elected Dean and board member of the Israeli Consular Corps (the sole official organization in Israel governing the work of about 150 Honorary Consuls in Israel).

Ami was elected as a board member of FICAC (the World Federation of Consuls). FICAC has been recognized as an NGO by the United Nations in 1993, initially with ROSTERECOSOC status upgraded in August 2018 to SPECIAL ECOSOC Status. It is also recognized as an NGO by the Organization of American States (OAS) and by the European Union (EU).

Ami is the legal adviser to the Korean government and its Embassy in Israel.

Ami is Chairman of the Israel-Korea Chamber of Commerce.
