



14th World Congress of Consuls FICAC Board of Directors Election Results

The World Federation of Consuls (FICAC) is the global network connecting consular associations and honorary consuls worldwide, dedicated to promoting consular excellence, international cooperation, and diplomatic education. More than 200 delegates from across the globe, representing 87 countries, convened in Marrakech, Morocco, for the 14th World Congress of Consuls, a significant gathering that combined high-level policy dialogue, leadership elections, and rich cultural experiences. Hosted by the Union of Honorary Consuls in Morocco (UCHM) at the prestigious Es Saadi Resort over four days, the Congress marked a defining moment in advancing international consular collaboration and strengthening diplomatic ties worldwide.
