

The Honorable Alessandro Giuliani was born in Italy and has pursued a distinguished professional and intellectual path marked by academic rigor, cultural breadth, and longstanding engagement with international affairs, particularly in economics, political science, and diplomacy.

He currently serves as Honorary Consul of the Republic of Poland in the Principality of Monaco, carrying out his duties with discretion, professionalism, and diplomatic acumen.

Concerning his academic background, he earned a Master of Business Administration (MBA) from *Università Commerciale Luigi Bocconi*, Milan, in 2002.

Earlier, in 2000, he completed a PhD in Political Science from *Università degli Studi Alma Ticinensis* of Pavia, where he specialized in international diplomatic politics, statistics, microeconomics, and macroeconomics. His thesis, entitled “*The League of Nations’ Policy towards the Japanese Invasion of Manchuria, 1931–1933*,” offered a critical, interdisciplinary examination of interwar diplomacy, treaty systems, and the evolving architecture of international relations.

His earlier studies concluded with a Scientific Baccalaureate from Liceo Scientifico in 1994, providing a solid grounding in both the sciences and the humanities.

Alongside his formal education, he complemented his studies with advanced programs and postgraduate specialization.

In 2004, he earned a Certificate of Completion from the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards program in Milan, focusing on “*Internationalization and the New Division of Labor: a Winning Challenge*”.

In 2000 and 2001, he attended specialized courses at the *Istituto per gli Studi di Politica Internazionale* (ISPI) in Milan, focusing respectively on NATO’s institutional development and the geopolitical, economic, and social dynamics of Sub-Saharan Africa — “*The Origins and Activities of NATO for its 50th Anniversary*” and “*The Sub-Saharan Africa*”.

These experiences reinforced his analytical approach to global governance and diplomatic institutions.

His intellectual and cultural development, strengthened by lifelong engagement with overseas perspectives, has been further enriched by extensive international experience across Europe, North America, Oceania, Asia, and the Middle East.

He undertook linguistic and cultural experiences in the United States — including New York, California, Maine, Florida, Michigan, Louisiana — and he completed English studies at *LAL School* (Fort Lauderdale) and *Embassy English School* (San Diego and San Francisco) in 2003.

He also spent extended periods in Texas (2007) and London (2004-2009), engaged in cultural pursuits; in Australia (2005-2006), from Melbourne to the Great Barrier Reef; and in Mexico (2010-2014), conducting research on the Mayan, Aztec, Olmec, and Zapotec civilizations.

Additional cultural residencies and research journeys have principally included Poland (2005-2025), as well as the United Arab Emirates, Japan, Hong Kong, Canada (Ontario and Québec), Turkey, Tunisia, Oman, Thailand and Morocco.

These global experiences cultivated a refined appreciation for architecture, cultural heritage, history, and languages, fostering a cosmopolitan perspective that informs his intellectual, personal, and professional life.

Professionally, he has combined entrepreneurship with a commitment to public service and diplomacy.

His earlier diplomatic experience includes service at the Embassy of Italy in the Principality of Monaco (2012-2013), where he assisted His Excellency the Ambassador with consular matters, cultural programming, and public relations activities, and contributed to the organization of the Month of Italian Language and Culture.

Since 2013, he has been the owner and director of his high-end organic food enterprise, overseeing marketing, administration, public relations and strategic market analysis.

From 2002 to 2012, he contributed to the management of his family's two-hundred-year-old artisan flour-mill business, coordinating sales and events and offering valuable insights into the Italian flour and food markets.

Guided by a conservative educational background and firm moral values, and in recognition of his civic and professional accomplishments, he has been honored with distinguished decorations: the *knighthood of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem* (a Pontifical Order) and the *Commandership of the Military and Religious Order of Saints Maurice and Lazarus* (a royal order).

He is also a member of the *Automobile Club de Monaco*.

His refined sense of human and institutional relations, together with a disciplined intellect and strong organizational abilities, distinguishes him as a professional of integrity, elegance, and discretion, capable of coordinating initiatives and fostering dialogue across cultural and diplomatic contexts.

He demonstrates a marked sensitivity to human needs, solid interpersonal and public-relations skills, and an aptitude for managing complex initiatives with precision and efficiency.

He is fluent in Italian, English, and French, and has a good knowledge of Spanish and Polish. He maintains a deep passion for architecture, cultural heritage, and the arts.
